Summary

Andro Chichinadze was arrested at his home on December 5, 2024, following his participation in anti-government protests. He was charged with group violence and subsequently sentenced to 2 years. Amnesty International documented evidence that his confession was obtained through torture, including physical abuse during interrogation.
